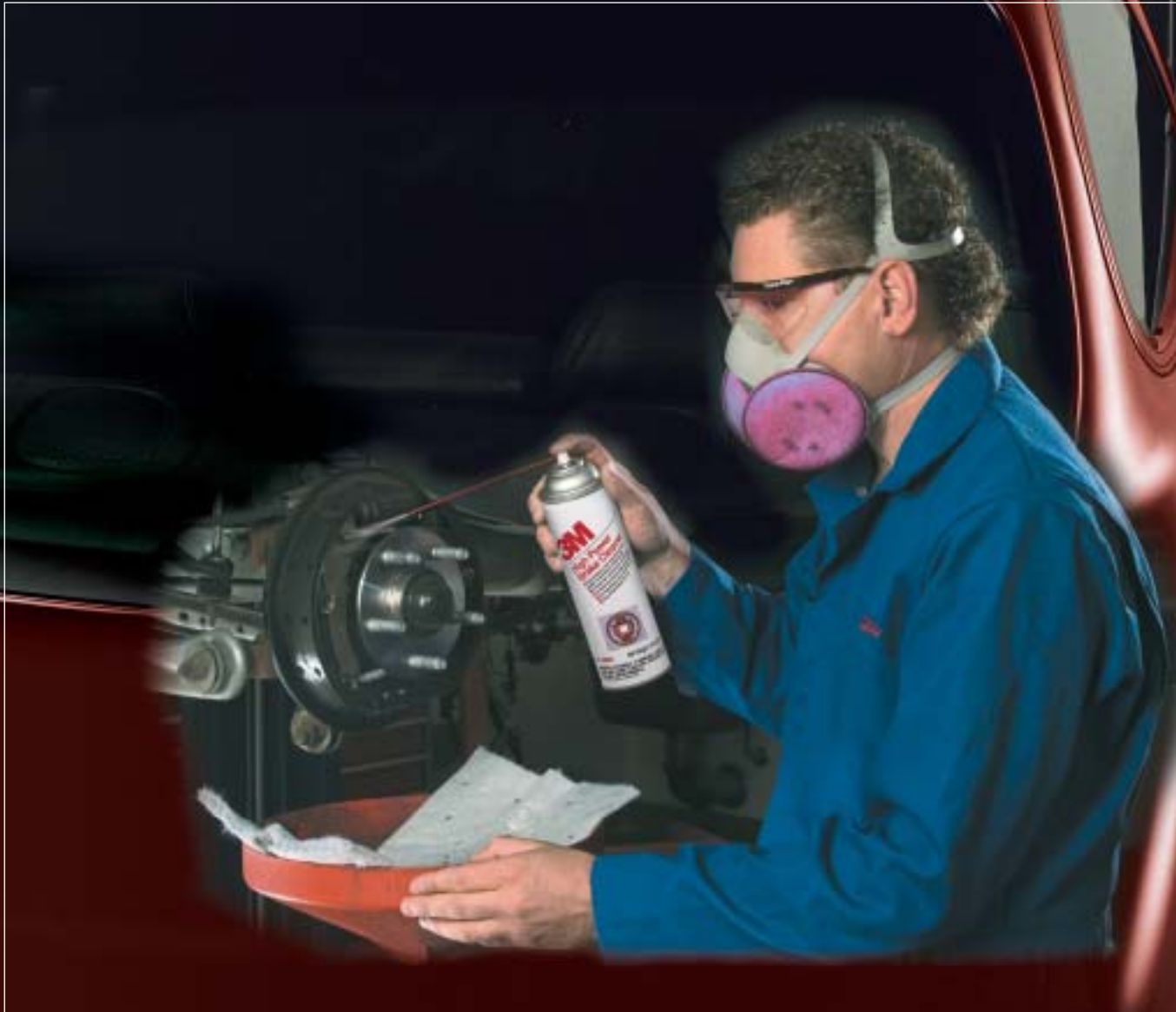

These respirators (when used with Filters 07000, P100) provide the same protection as the respirator packout shown above. Replacement Filter 07000, P100 must be ordered separately.



## Filter 07000, P100

This filter was developed specifically for use in areas in which particles, such as asbestos, are present. It is especially effective in shops where brake and clutch repair work is being done.



## WARNING

Each respirator must be properly selected based on the contaminant and concentration levels to which the worker is exposed. Respirators shown may be used for exposures below 10X the PEL or applicable government occupational exposure limits, whichever is lower.

Failure to follow the use and fitting instructions and warnings for proper use contained on the respirator packaging and/or failure to wear the respirator during all times of exposure can reduce respirator effectiveness and **may result in sickness or death.**
