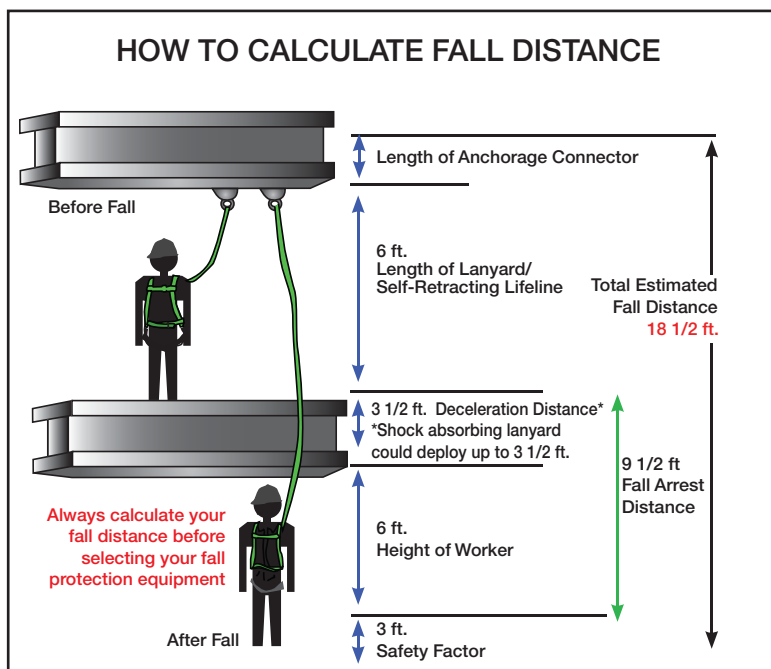

REW-7 is an excellent fall protection solution for workers exposed to a fall hazard with less than 18.5' of fall clearance from their tie-off point. When fall clearance is less than 18.5', use of a 6' shock absorbing lanyard could pose serious risks to worker safety. To understand how this works, refer the diagram on the right.

REW-7 reduces the amount of clearance height required in part because of the product's ability to reduce the maximum free fall to 2' when compared against the 6' length of a standard shock absorbing lanyard. Actual fall distances depend on multiple factors, such as the location of the fall protection anchorage and harness fit. It is important to consult with a competent person to calculate fall clearances correctly. Failure to calculate fall distances correctly could result in serious injury to the worker or even death.

As an approved self-retracting lifeline, REW-7 is less likely to prematurely lock-up during normal use than a personal fall limiter (PFL). Also, lightweight retractables are a smart choice for organizations concerned with trip hazards. Lightweight retractables are less likely than shock absorbing lanyards to become a work hindrance since the lifeline retracts into the housing when not in use.
