3M Pink Hand Soap is a general purpose liquid hand soap designed for use in bulk hand-soap dispensers wherever hand washing is done.

General Use Directions:

Prepare soap dispenser:

- Empty old soap from existing dispenser and thoroughly clean to remove all old soap and soil build-up.
- Rinse dispensers to remove any residue.
- Disinfection of soap dispensers will minimize bacterial growth on dispenser, however, after disinfecting you must rinse with water prior to filling with soap.

1. Dilute 3M Pink Hand Soap with cold water using the 3M Twist 'n Fill™ dispenser into a properly labeled one-gallon container.
2. Pour ready-to-use hand soap into cleaned dispenser.
3. Store remaining hand soap in a closed container for future use.
4. Refill soap dispenser as needed.
