3M™ Detail Compound 308 is a fast cutting compound recommended for use to remove oxidation, scratches, and stains, and leaves a medium gloss finish on all types of automotive paints. To minimize the possibility of staining, do not apply in direct sunlight or onto a hot surface.

Directions for Use: Compound using an electric buffer (1000 to 2500 RPM) equipped with a 3M™ Superbuff™ Polishing Pad or a 3M™ Perfect-It™ Foam Compounding Pad.

1. Shake container before using.
2. Apply enough compound to the paint surface to work a 2'x2' area. To minimize slinging, spread the polish over the surface with the pad before starting the machine.
3. Start the machine and buff using light to medium pressure.
4. Reduce pressure as the compound begins to dry and buff to a medium gloss. Clean pad as necessary to assist cleanup.

Protect from freezing. If frozen, thaw and shake well before using.
