# Nomad™ Terra 8100 Matting

## Product Description

Nomad™ Terra 8100 is an unbacked entrance matting material having an open structure of continuous coiled coarse vinyl filaments, bonded together to form an attractive flooring product. It collects dirt, and prevents it from being tracked into a building. Being unbacked it allows dirt to fall through the loops for easy cleaning. It is oil resistant and suitable for heavy duty foot traffic, in both wet or dry conditions.

Nomad™ Terra 8100 is designed for entrances (recessed matwells, or free-standing applications), outside or inside, especially for use in factory areas or other areas exposed to oily contaminants and/or heavy traffic (1,500 - 5,000 crossings per day).
