Light Soiling

1. Shake the can well.
2. Turn the can's spray tip so the arrow points to the dot on the can's rim.
3. Hold the can upright 6 in. to 12 in. from the surface.
4. Spray lightly directly on the surface or on a clean, dry cloth.
5. Wipe the area with a clean, dry cloth and polish until dry.

Heavy Soiling

1. Spray 3M™ Stainless Steel Cleaner and Polish onto a Scotch-Brite™ Light Duty Scrubbing Pad 9030 or Scotch-Brite™ Light Duty Scrub Sponge 63.
2. Vigorously rub the surface to remove the heavy soil. Always rub stainless steel in the direction of the grain.
3. Wipe the surface with a clean, dry cloth to remove any excess cleaner.
4. Use a clean dry cloth to buff in the direction of the grain to achieve maximum shine.
