## Road Traffic Regulations 1992

The Road Traffic (Carriage of Dangerous Substances in Road Tankers and Tank Containers) Regulations 1992, require that during the delivery/unloading of petrol, a suitable quantity of absorbent material must be available as a contingency against spills.
