

Course Description

The 3M Endorsed DI-NOC Installer Program is comprised of two elements: a two-day training course and a two-day testing session.

Two-day training: covers the skills and knowledge necessary to apply DI-NOC architectural films in an interior design setting. Completion of the training will allow participants to confidently complete DI-NOC applications using appropriate materials, tools and techniques. Applications include, but are not limited to, flat surfaces, door wrapping, complex curves, corners and more. In addition to application techniques, other training topics include surface preparation, installation considerations, and maintenance and repair recommendations.

Two-day testing: Successful completion of this test earns participants the 3M Endorsed DI-NOC Installer designation. This two-day test is comprised of 11 different application stations that participants are required to successfully complete. Application techniques tested are taught during the training session. Participation in the training and testing does not guarantee earning the 3M Endorsed DI-NOC Installer designation.

1. Registration - Course availability is on a first-come, first-served basis. Places can only be reserved by submitting a completed registration form and sending a check for full payment. Registrations must be received at least three weeks prior to the course date.
2. Maximum Class Size - Maximum class size is limited to 6 people to ensure a high quality training experience. Any registrations received after the maximum of 6 participants has been reached will be placed on a waiting list and advised if a position becomes available. Any registrations that cannot be accommodated in one of the participant's three preferred dates specified on the registration form will receive first preference for the next available class. 3M is not responsible for any travel-related cancellation fees.
3. Minimum Class Size - Minimum class size is 3 people. The class may be canceled or postponed if the minimum is not reached. Any registrations for canceled classes will receive first preference on the next available class.
4. Cancellation Policy - Cancellations made more than two weeks prior to the start day of the course will not be charged for the course. Cancellations made between 14 and 7 days in advance of start day of the course will incur a fee of 50% of the course fee. Cancellations must be made by phone. Call 3M AMD Customer Service at 1-888-650-3497. Cancellations within 7 days of the course start date or no-shows on the day of the course will be charged the full course cost.
5. Upon successful completion of the 3M Endorsed DI-NOC Installer Test, participants may complete an application to access the 3M Endorsed DI-NOC Installer designation, including branding assets and inclusion on 3M's Architectural Market's website. Application requires proof of liability insurance.
