




## **Fitting Instructions**




Thread the top and bottom straps through their respective buckles. Ensure that they remain untwisted.




With one hand, cup the respirator under your chin with the nosepiece facing upwards. Take both straps in your other hand.







Locate the upper strap across the crown of the head and the lower strap below the ears. Straps must not be twisted.








If you CANNOT achieve a proper fit DO NOT enter the hazardous area. See your supervisor.



Tighten the straps to secure the respirator.

> To increase tension, pull evenly on both ends of the top and bottom straps.

To decrease tension, without removing respirator, push out on the back of the buckles.




Ensure face seal is properly formed around the nose.





The seal of the respirator on the face should be fitchecked before entering the workplace.

Before fitting your respirator, make sure that your face is clean shaven. Respirators must not be worn with stubble, beards or other facial hair under the area of the face seal as these can prevent a good seal to the face. Make sure that long hair is tied back and jewellery is removed so that it does not interfere with the seal to the face.
