Competent Person Refresher Training

Course description:

This refresher training demonstrates skillsets of a Competent Person and informs students on the new regulation standards and equipment of a Competent Person.

Students will expand their knowledge and ability to identify hazardous conditions, develop programs and make equipment selections to properly deal with fall hazards. Upon successful completion of this course, the student will receive a certificate acknowledging they have met or exceeded OSHA, ANSI and CSA requirements as a Competent Person.

Duration:

1 day, all locations.

Recommended attendance:

Competent Person refresher training shall be conducted at least every two years to stay current with the fall protection and rescue educational industry requirements, when new fall protection systems are used or installed, or new fall hazards are encountered.
