

Upcycled Metal BOOKENDS

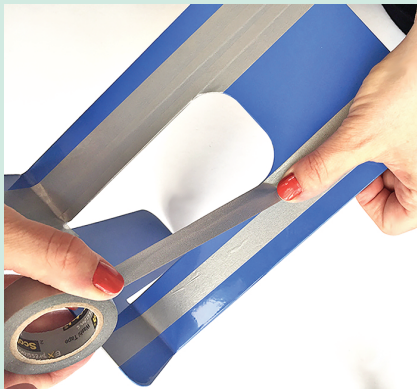
with Scotch® Expressions Washi and Glitter Tape

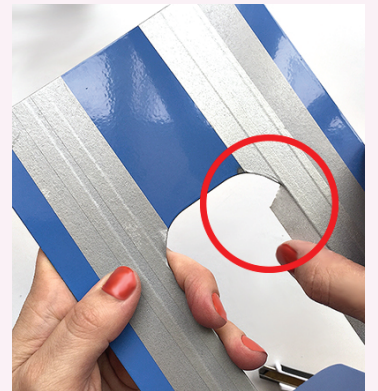


Metal bookends are one of those really useful office accessories which just don't have a lot of style. So let me show you how to transform them into something lovely and useful! All you need is Scotch® Expressions Washi and Glitter Tape, some clean small jars (I used the baby food ones) and super glue (I used the Scotch® Single Use Super Glue it was really easy to deal with). Below are the step by step instructions on how to transform the bookends. Have fun!

Step One: Cover the metal bookends with rows of washi tape. Try to keep the tape as tidy as possible.



Tip: When you get to a corner, make a tiny cut in the tape and then fold the tape over in separate pieces - this will make it easier and look nice and neat.



Step Two: Decorate your jars with washi tape. I wrapped mine with colours I love.



Then I added detail with glitter tape - stripes and triangles I cut out with scissors.



Step Three: Super glue the jars to the base of the book ends.



Step Four: Fill the jars as you wish! They make cute vases or you can store handy stationery in them. All done!
