

## **Application Instructions**



Position Tegaderm<sup>™</sup> Contact Layer over wound.



If absorbent filler is needed, fill with  $3M^{\infty}$  Tegaderm<sup> $\infty$ </sup> High Integrity Alginate Dressing or other suitable dressing. If moisture is needed for drier wounds, use  $3M^{\infty}$  Tegaderm<sup> $\infty$ </sup> Hydrogel Wound Filler.



Dress wound with appropriate secondary dressing such as 3M<sup>™</sup> Tegaderm<sup>™</sup> Foam Dressing (nonadhesive), a 3M<sup>™</sup> Tegaderm<sup>™</sup> Transparent Film Dressing, gauze or other suitable dressing. Secure secondary dressing as appropriate.



Tegaderm<sup>™</sup> Contact Layer may be applied under 3M<sup>™</sup> Coban<sup>™</sup> 2 Layer Compression System or 3M<sup>™</sup> Coban<sup>™</sup> Self-Adherent Wrap.

## **Removal Instructions**



Remove Tegaderm<sup>™</sup> Contact Layer by gently lifting. If wound surface appears dry, first moisten material with sterile saline.
