Cleaning Instructions

Squeegee can be rinsed with warm or hot water or soaked in a cleaning solution to dissolve caked-on soil and grease.

Worn-out squeegee base, handle, blade can be disposed of in regular kitchen trash.

Cleaning by Hand

1. Wash squeegee in soapy water to remove any remaining soil. Remove embedded soil from it by hand, or use a cloth or scour pad.
2. Rinse with clean water and dry it.

Cleaning by Dish Washer

1. Spray off or rinse excess soil debris from squeegee using dish sprayer or sink faucet. Remove stubborn soil debris from it by hand, or use a cloth or scour pad.
2. Place in dishwasher and make sure it is exposed to washing.
3. After washing, take it out of dishwasher and allow to air dry.
