How to Apply 3M[™] Tegaderm[™] High Performance Foam Adhesive Dressings for Wound Care Management

Use this step-by-step guide to apply dressings with care and precision.


Supplies needed

3M™ Tegaderm™ High Performance Foam Adhesive Dressings — ensure foam pad is larger than wound area
Disposable Exam gloves
Saline or irrigation solution
Lint-free cloths
Clean towels or underpads to protect patient and surfaces
3M™ Cavilon™ No Sting Barrier Film, as necessary
Small plastic bag for soiled cloths, gloves and dressing packaging


Prior to Application

Preparation



Wash hands and set up a clean area with supplies. Apply gloves.


Cleanse wound and skin



Cleanse wound and surrounding skin.

Remove soiled gloves and wash hands. Discard soiled gloves into plastic bag. Put on a new set of disposable gloves before applying the dressing.

Protect fragile skin




If the skin surrounding the wound is fragile or exposure to wound exudate fluid is likely:

Apply a barrier film, such as 3M™ Cavilon™ No Sting Barrier Film. Follow instructions for use. Let dry.

If you believe there is an infection present, contact your health care provider. Tegaderm foam dressing may be used on infected wounds only under the care of a health care provider.

Applying the Dressing


Prepare dressing




Remove dressing from package.

Hold the dressing by one of the side tabs and remove the printed liner to expose the adhesive border.

Position Dressing




While holding the side tabs, position the dressing over the wound and apply.



Gently press the adhesive film border to the skin.


Avoid stretching the dressing or the skin during application.



Remove paper carrier one section at a time.

Begin at the center of the dressing, grasp one section of the paper carrier and pull toward the outer edge of the dressing while gently pressing down the film border. Repeat for each remaining section until all paper carrier is removed.

Discard packaging




Discard dressing packaging and gloves into plastic bag.

Discard in regular household trash.

Heel/Contour Surface Application

Preparation




Remove dressing from package.

Hold the dressing by one of the side tabs and remove the printed liner, exposing the adhesive border.


Position Dressing



While stabilizing the leg or surrounding skin with one hand, position the dressing over the wound.



With one hand, press or "cup" the dressing onto the skin.




Continue to press and conform the dressing and adhesive border onto the skin.




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


Firmly press and conform the adhesive border to the skin.

Dressing Removal



Gently lift the adhesive film border while pressing down on the skin.



If there is difficulty lifting the film border:

Apply adhesive tape to the edge of the dressing and use the tape to lift.
