

Employee Training on Respiratory Protection

The U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Respiratory <u>29 CFR 1910.134</u>, specifies requirements for employers assigning respiratory protection to workers in the United States. Those requirements include a site-specific written respiratory protection program, medical evaluations, respirator fit testing, wearer training, and program evaluation – among other requirements. Training of employees who are required to wear respiratory protection must take place at least annually.

Your annual training must include the following topics:

- 1. Respiratory hazards
- 2. Uses and limitations (see below)
- 3. Donning and adjustment (see below)
- 4. Hands-on practice
- 5. User seal check (see below)
- 6. Maintenance and storage (see below)
- 7. Medical signs and symptoms
- 8. Training documentation (see below)
