1. For best results, remove water from the toilet bowl by forcing it over the trap with a swab mop.
2. Thoroughly wet the toilet application surfaces with 3M™ Acid Bowl Cleaner Ready-to-Use.
3. Scrub immediately with a Scotch-Brite™ Toilet Bowl Scrub, Scotch-Brite™ Power Pad 2000, or Scotch-Brite™ Light Duty Scouring Pad No. 98.
4. Make sure to clean under the rim of the bowl or urinal. Application of additional product may be necessary.
5. Allow the cleaner several minutes to remove the stains.
6. Rinse the bowl or urinal by flushing.
