



# Certified Instructor Fall Protection Authorized Person

## Course Description

Educating and training workers is not only a regulatory requirement for employers but is also a critical element to improving worksite safety. For many employers, having an on-site instructor is a beneficial asset for providing timely, consistent safety training to workers on-site.
