The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) has reviewed your request accepted November 30, 2020. This request was for extensions of approvals TC-84A-0376, TC-84A-0022, TC-84A-0071, TC-84A-5536, TC-84A-5544 and TC-84A-5894 to add exhalation valve filter assembly 604 as an accessory to 6000 series halfmask respirator assemblies. The complete respirator configurations are detailed on assembly matrix file names 78-8099-8529-0AMbv, revision BV, dated 01-07-21 and 78-8150-4123-7AMad.xls, revision AD, dated 01-07-21.

This request is granted. Approvals are granted only for documentation written in the English language. It is the manufacturer's responsibility to correctly translate materials desired in languages other than English.

Since this request does not affect the full approval labels, final labels are not enclosed.
