### 3M PSD Occupational Health and Safety Scholarship Program Rules

It is your responsibility to review the following rules and requirements. Any submission that does not meet all criteria outlined on this page will not be considered.

#### To be considered:

- Applicants must be currently enrolled in, or accepted into, a graduate Occupational Health and Safety/Industrial Hygiene program at a university in the United States.
- Applicants must have at least one year remaining\* in their graduate studies from the Application Deadline. (Graduation date of Spring 2023 at the earliest.)
   \*Note: 3M recognizes that some graduate study programs may be less than 2 years in length. Therefore, applicants with less than 1 year remaining will still be considered, however the scholarship amount may be prorated.
- Applicants must prepare a cover letter, of no more than two pages, describing their accomplishments, career goals, commitment to the profession and why they deserve the scholarship.
- An official current school transcript, including grade point average, must be included with each application. Providing an official undergraduate transcript is also advised, but not required.
- Two letters of recommendation, one preferably from a certified industrial hygienist or certified safety professional or equivalent certification, must be included with the application.

In addition to the scholarship, 3M PSD will provide each awardee with registration to the American Industrial Hygiene Conference and Expo (AIHCE) May 23-25 2021.

*PLEASE NOTE*: Scholarship awardees will not be reimbursed for any existing/previously made conference registrations.

- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the awardee's educational institution and must be applied toward costs of tuition, research, books or other expenses appropriate to their graduate studies at the discretion of their academic advisor.
- Each scholarship awardee must be prepared to verify use of scholarship funds and AIHCE expenses in accordance with the 3M PSD Scholarship Program Rules.
- Due to evolving health and safety considerations related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the type of AIHCE registration provided to scholarship awardees (virtual or in-person attendance) will be determined by 3M in April 2022.
