Daily use may improve a floor's visual appearance including cleanliness, gloss, and distinctness of image (DOI), depending on floor type and condition. This product is designed to be used as part of the 3M™ Concrete Floor Polishing and Maintenance System in combination with the Scotch-Brite™ Diamond Floor Brush.

- Effectively cleans uncoated concrete floors
- Strengthens the stone floor to allow for a better polish vs water

Applications

3M™ Concrete Cleaner & Densifier is designed for use on <u>uncoated</u>* concrete floors. It is also suitable for use on <u>uncoated</u>* calcium based stones including marble, travertine, limestone, and cement based terrazzo hard floor surfaces.

- *Uncoated refers to floors without any crystallization or topical coatings such as acrylic, urethane, or epoxy based coatings. This system is usable on floors with a densifier or impregnator.
- Use with an auto scrubber, mop and bucket, or a flat mop.

Packaging

3M™ Concrete Cleaner & Densifier Concentrate #36A

• 0.5-gallon bottle - four bottles per case

Each 0.5-gallon bottle yields 190 ready-to-use gallons. (Dilution ratio of 1:380.)

3M™ Concrete Cleaner & Densifier Bulk

• 1-gallon container - four containers per case

Each 1-gallon container yields 384 ready-to-use gallons. (Dilution ratio of 1:384)

General Use Directions

Autoscrubber or Mop & Bucket

Flush out the autoscrubber or reservoir with fresh water to remove any chemical residue.

3M™ Flow Control Chemical Management System Wall Mount Dispenser

Dispense 3M[™] Concrete Cleaner & Densifier #36A with cold water into a mop bucket or directly into an auto scrubber, using the 3M[™] Flow Control Chemical Management System Wall Mount Dispenser or the 3M[™] Portable Flow Control Dispenser.

Bulk Dispensing

Dispense 3M[™] Concrete Cleaner & Densifier Bulk at the proper dilution ratio after calculating the container volume of either a buddy jug, mop bucket, or autoscrubber. Use with cold water.

NOTE: Dilute 1 oz of chemicals from the bulk container with 3 gallons of cold water.

Use Instructions

- 1. Dust floors using a 3M[™] Easy Trap[™] Duster.
- 2. Properly position caution signs for wet floor conditions.
- 3. Mop the floor or scrub it using an auto scrubber or floor machine with a Scotch-Brite™ Diamond Floor Brush or other appropriate cleaning pad.
- 4. Pick up soiled solution with an autoscrubber, wet vacuum, or a tightly wrung mop.
- 5. No rinsing required.
- 6. Allow the floor to dry.

NOTE: Floors may be slippery when wet.
