# **Applications**

Use Scotch-Brite™ White Floor Pad for dry polishing of protected or non-protected floors under standard speed rotary floor machines.

It can also be used for light spray cleaning on fragile surfaces such as glazed ceramic.

### **Directions for Use**

- Install a clean floor pad under the machine pad holder
- Dust mop the area
- Dry buff a section of floor in 2 passes
- · Move backwards to next section
- Dust mop entire floor area
- Remove pad and wash after use

Note: floors must be clean, free of soil and in dry condition prior to dry buffing.

# Maintenance and Cleaning

- · Remove floor pad from machine after each use and shake dust out of pad
- Rinse wash under tap water (or machine wash every 5 uses)
- Hang up for drying. Do not use wet!

Note: machine washed floor pads will shrink about 20 mm after first washing cycle. Recommended washing-machine temperature is 40°C.
