How Do You Know If Your Fall Protection Equipment Are Still in Good Condition?

Fall protection equipment, such as body harnesses and lanyards, are often used by workers in harsh workplace environment where mechanical abrasion or chemical exposure is present. These equipment can become damaged or worn to the point that it is no longer safe for use. This can include rips, tears, bent hooks and latches, corrosion or any other defects.

One of the biggest challenge in most workplace is how to correctly identify these defects and remove them from service to avoid equipment failure in event of a fall. To address this gap, ANSI Z359.1-2007 standard stipulates that equipment needs to be inspected by a competent person each year. BS EN 365 also states that periodic examinations are only to be conducted by a competent person authorized by the manufacturer and strictly in accordance with manufacturer's procedures.
