3M™ Polyester Tape 8992 is used to mask off areas from paint during the powder coating process.

Application Description:


Dry powder is sprayed through an applicator that applies an electrostatic charge to the powder particles, which are attracted to a grounded metalized surface. The powder covered part is then cured at a temperature of 400°F/204°C or greater for a typical bake cycle of 5–30 minutes. The powder coating chemically reacts at elevated temperatures, resulting in a highly cross-linked durable coating.

Application Benefits:

- Powder coating increases the durability and abrasion resistance of the part
- Protects parts from corrosion and provides a visually aesthetic appearance

Key Application Requirements:

- Must withstand elevated temperatures, provide a crisp paint line with no edge bleed, and remove cleanly after use
- Colored for easy identification and linered for die-cut ability to create on-demand stickers



After the powder coat bake cycle, 3M™ Polyester Tape 8992 removes cleanly in one piece.
