

Heavy Metals in Packaging Certificate of Compliance

We certify that:

1. All packages and package components sold to 3M Company and its affiliates (“3M Entities”) by our company or any affiliates (the “Sold Packaging”) comply with (a) the heavy metals content requirements of the United States Model Toxics in Packaging laws enacted by various states under The Toxics in Packaging Clearinghouse (TPCH), formerly known as the Coalition of Northeastern Governors (“CONEG”); (b) the heavy metals content requirements of the California Toxics in Packaging Prevention Act, Cal. Health & Safety Code Sections 25214.11-25214.26, and (c) the heavy metals content requirements of the European Parliament and Council Directive 94/62/EC on Packaging and Packaging Waste (“Directive 94/62/EC”).
2. There is no intentionally added lead, mercury, cadmium or hexavalent chromium in the Sold Packaging.
3. The sum concentration levels of lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium added together in any Sold Packaging do not exceed more than 100 parts per million by weight.
4. No materials used to replace the heavy metals lead, mercury, cadmium or hexavalent chromium in the Sold Packaging are present in a quantity or manner that creates a hazard as great or greater than the hazard created by the regulated metals. (Iowa Admin. Rules Section 567-213.4(445D)).
5. Any Sold Packaging that is part of a finished packaged product also meets the Essential Requirements on the Composition and the Reusable and Recoverable, Including Recyclable, Nature of Packaging in Annex II of Directive 94/62/EC.
6. We will monitor and inform 3M of changes made on our part or by our suppliers that may affect the status of this certification.
