Dispense 3M[™] 3-in-1 Floor Cleaner Concentrate 24A with cold water into a mop bucket or auto scrubber reservoir using the 3M[™] Flow Control System Wall Mount Dispenser or the 3M[™] Flow Control System Portable Dispenser.

Dispense 3M[™] 3-in-1 Floor Cleaner Concentrate 24H with cold water into a mop bucket or auto scrubber reservoir using the 3M[™] Twist 'n Fill[™] Cleaning Chemical Management System.

Routine Cleaning

- 1. Sweep or dust mop floors using a 3M[™] Easy Trap Duster.
- 2. Properly place caution signs for wet floor conditions.

- 4. Allow the floor to dry completely.
- 5. Burnish the floor (optional).
- 6. Dust the floor using a 3M[™] Easy Trap Duster.
- 7. Apply one or two coats of floor finish as recommended by the manufacturer's guidelines.
