General Use Directions

Refer to ready-to-use SDS for personal protective equipment (PPE) recommendations.

Dispense 3M[™] TroubleShooter[™] Finish Remover using the 3M[™] Twist 'n Fill[™] dispenser into a trigger spray bottle, pail or mop bucket. Remove bottle and flush dispenser with water.

Baseboards and Floors

- 1. Dispense 3M[™] TroubleShooter[™] Finish Remover using the 3M[™] Twist 'n Fill[™] dispenser directly into a properly labeled spray bottle or hand pail.
- 2. Apply solution to the surface.
- 3. Wait three to five minutes to allow solution to penetrate the soil.
- Scrub with 3M[™] Doodlebug[™] Holder fitted with the appropriate 3M[™] Doodlebug[™] Pad.
- 5. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and a wet mop or cloth. Follow up with a damp mop or cloth.

Coverage (approximate):

- 50 square feet per quart of diluted product
- 150 linear feet of 4-inch baseboard per quart

Other Surfaces

- 1. To remove heavy soil and soap scum buildup apply solution to the surface.
- 2. Wait three to five minutes to allow solution to penetrate the soil.
- 3. Scrub with the appropriate 3M[™] Scotch-Brite[™] Hand Pad or sponge.
- 4. Rinse with clean water. Flush dispenser with water.
