3M™ TroubleShooter™ Liquid Finish Remover is a ready-to-use, heavy-duty baseboard stripper that is applied with a trigger sprayer, mop, or brush on baseboards and other hard-to-reach surfaces. 3M™ TroubleShooter™ Liquid Finish Remover is especially suitable for cleaning heavy soiling, wax, and floor finish buildup.

## General Use Directions

### NOTE

Refer to the 3M™ TroubleShooter™ Liquid Finish Remover SDS for personal protective equipment recommendations.

### CAUTION

Do NOT apply to painted surfaces, plastic surfaces, old baseboards, linoleum, old asphalt tile, soft metal, or other surfaces that are easily scratched.

### NOTE

To remove heavy buildup especially along baseboards, apply 3M™ TroubleShooter™ Liquid Finish Remover and scrub using a 3M™ Doodlebug™ pad fitted to a 3M™ Doodlebug™ pad holder. When using an automatic scrubber equipped with an appropriate 3M pad, allow the stripping solution to remain wet on the floor for at least five minutes before agitation and pickup.

1. Prior to full adoption, test the product on a small, inconspicuous area to ensure product performance and surface compatibility conform to user expectations. Note any changes in color or texture, particularly on old tile floors.
2. Apply the chemical to the surface.
3. Let sit three to five minutes before scrubbing. Reapplication may be required based on thickness of coating.
4. Scrub with a wet Scotch-Brite™ Medium Duty Sponge 74, 3M™ Doodlebug™ Blue Pad 8242 fitted to a 3M™ Doodlebug™ Pad Holder 6472, or 3M™ Doodlebug™ Brown Scrub 'n Strip Pad 8541. For floors, scrub with a floor machine equipped with a 3M™ Black Stripper Pad 7200 or 3M™ Brown Stripper Pad 7100.
5. Wipe the area clean with a damp cloth. For floors, wet vacuum the application area and rinse.

## Directions for Use in Showers

1. Prior to full adoption, test the product on a small, inconspicuous area to ensure product performance and surface compatibility conform to user expectations. Note any changes in color or texture.
2. Soak a Scotch-Brite™ Light Duty Scrub Sponge 63, Scotch-Brite™ ocelo™ sponge, or 3M™ Doodlebug™ White Cleansing Pad 8440 fitted to a 3M™ Doodlebug™ Pad Holder 6472 with 3M™ TroubleShooter™ Liquid Finish Remover.
3. Apply the chemical to the shower surface. After application the surface should be visibly wet.
4. Let the product sit on the surface for three to five minutes. Reapplication may be required based on thickness of coating.
5. Scrub the application area using a 3M™ Doodlebug™ White Cleansing Pad 8440 or Scotch-Brite™ Light Duty Scrub Sponge 63.
6. Rinse and let dry.
