Description:

The Scotch-Brite™ Stainless Steel Scrubber 83, 84, and 84CC are stainless steel scrubber balls wound together using a single coiled stainless steel wire strand. The wire strand is made from high quality AISI 400 series stainless steel. The scrubbers are designed for tough kitchen cleaning jobs.

Special Features:

- Single wire strand construction to eliminate multiple ends.
- High quality grade stainless steel to withstand breakage under normal usage and provide durability and corrosion resistance from exposure to hot water, detergents and normal cleaning liquids.

Applications:

Use for cleaning, scouring, and scrubbing pots, pans, baking dishes, broiler pans, grills and ovens. Excellent performance in removing baked-on food from cookware.

Packaging:

Stainless steel scrubbers are individually packaged and inserted in cartons.

General Use Directions:

The 83, 84, and 84CC scrubbers can be used wet or dry.

1. Hold scrubber with one hand.
2. Place scrubber against the surface to be cleaned, apply desired pressure and scrub the area in circular motion.
3. Rinse off scrubbed areas with clean water.
4. Clean scrubber as necessary after use.

Scrubber Cleaning Instructions:

Cleaning scrubber provides multiple uses. Used and/or worn-out scrubbers can be disposed of in regular kitchen trash.

Scrubbers can be rinsed with warm hot water or soaked in a cleaning solution to dissolve caked-on soil and grease.

1. Spray or rinse off excess food debris from scrubber using a dish sprayer or sink faucet.
2. Wash the scrubber in soapy water to remove any remaining food debris and grease. Remove imbedded food debris from scrubber by hand.
3. Rinse the scrubber with clean water. Make sure no food debris is left in the scrubber. Shake excess water from the scrubber and allow to air dry.
