

Scotchgard™ Vehicle Protection Package - Application Chart *Professional Series*



Scotchgard™ Carpet Protector (PN 38602)

Helps to resist carpet stains

- 1. Apply to clean, colorfast fabrics.
- 2. Shake well before spraying.
- 3. Hold spray bottle 6 inches from fabric.
- 4. Overlap spray using a sweeping motion to evenly treat carpet.
- 5. Allow carpet to dry completely, typically 1-4 hours*. If white residue remains on carpet after drying due to over application, simply remove with light brushing.

Note: Wipe any overspray off adjacent surfaces to avoid visible residual or staining. This can be removed with water and a clean cloth.

Do **not** use Scotchgard[™] Carpet Protector on fabric and upholstery. Scotchgard[™] Fabric and Upholstery Protector should be used on fabric and upholstery.

*Dry times can vary significantly by climate type. Dry times will be shorter in dry climates and longer in humid environments.



Scotchgard™ Fabric and Upholstery Protector (PN 38617)

Helps stop spills from staining your seats

- 1. Apply to clean, colorfast fabrics.
- 2. Shake well before spraying.
- 3. Hold can upright and 6" from fabric surface.
- 4. Overlap spray using a sweeping motion to evenly treat fabric. Two light coats are better than one heavy coat. **Note:** Allow fabric to dry between coats.
- 5. Allow fabric to dry completely, typically 1 to 4 hours*.

Application Tip: On upholstery, avoid heavy application and saturation into foam cushioning. A light spray coating once in the horizontal direction and once in the vertical direction should be sufficient. If necessary, a second light spray may be applied after first one has dried.

Note: Wipe any overspray off adjacent surfaces to avoid visible residual or staining. This can be removed with water and a clean cloth.

*Dry times can vary significantly by climate type. Dry times will be shorter in dry climates and longer in humid environments.



Scotchgard[™] Leather and Vinyl Protector (PN 38601)

Helps protect interior surfaces

- 1. Test in an inconspicuous area before use.
- 2. Put a small amount of creamy gel on a clean cloth.
- 3. Spread evenly, using a circular motion, working the gel into the surface.
- 4. Dirty or textured surfaces may require a second application.
- 5. Turn cloth frequently and buff to a gloss until surface is dry. Do not leave surface wet or covered with excessive product.

Note: Wipe off any excess material in seams, edges, or adjacent areas with a dry, clean cloth. If product gets on carpet, remove using a damp, clean cloth.



Scotchgard™ Paint Protector (PN 38600)

Safeguards your car's exterior finish

Wash and dry vehicle. Do not apply in direct sunlight or onto a hot surface.

Hand application:

- 1. Apply a thin, uniform film to the paint surface using a terry cloth wax applicator or a clean, soft, cotton terry cloth towel. Do not allow to dry to a haze.
- 2. Apply and remove product one panel at a time.
- 3. Remove residue and buff to a high gloss using a 3M[™] Perfect-It[™] Detailing Cloth (PN 06016).
- 4. Remove any excess product from adjacent surfaces (glass, vinyl, rubber) using a 3M[™] Perfect-It[™] Detailing Cloth (PN 06016).

Tool Application (most time efficient application method):

Using a 6" D/A (Dual Action) sander equipped with a 3M[™] Hookit[™] Clean Sand Painter's Backup Pad (PN 05551) and a Foam Applicator Pad:

- 1. Apply a thin uniform film to the paint surface using a DA equipped with a Foam Applicator Pad. Do not allow to dry to a haze.
- 2. Apply and remove product one panel at a time.
- 3. Buff to a high gloss with a polisher equipped with a clean, dry, terry cloth bonnet or by hand using a 3M[™] Perfect-It[™] Detailing Cloth (PN 06016).
- 4. Remove any excess product from adjacent surfaces (glass, vinyl, rubber) using a 3M[™] Perfect-It[™] Detailing Cloth (PN 06016).

Note: Allowing this product to dry to a haze is not recommended and can make removal difficult. If the product becomes dry or difficult to remove, use a damp 3M[™] Perfect-It[™] Detailing Cloth (PN 06016). A second coat is not necessary but can be applied if desired.

Important: 3M[™] Paint Protection Film, graphics, or striping tape should be applied before the Paint Protector is applied.
