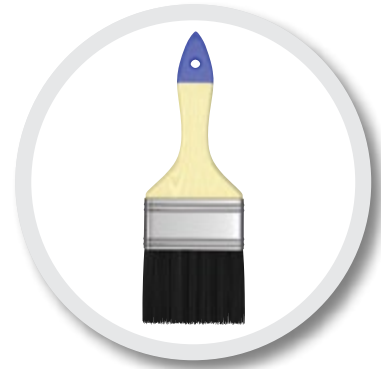
Required Application Technique

You must scrub. Per manufacturer's instructions for use: "Dry Site (such as abdomen or arm) Use repeated back-and-forth strokes of the sponge for approximately 30 seconds. Completely wet the treatment area with antiseptic.

Moist Site (such as the inguinal fold) Use repeated back-and-forth strokes of the sponge for approximately 2 minutes. Completely wet the treatment area with antiseptic."



You can paint. Per manufacturer's instructions for use: "Paint a single, uniform application and do not go back over areas already prepped."
