### Description

3M™ General Purpose Cleaner Concentrate 8A is a concentrated product to be diluted and dispensed using the 3M™ Flow Control System Wall Mount Dispenser or the 3M™ Flow Control System Portable Dispenser.

3M™ General Purpose Cleaner Concentrate 8H and 8L are concentrated products to be diluted and dispensed using the 3M™ Twist 'n Fill™ Cleaning Chemical Management System.

Ready-to-use general purpose cleaner is formulated to clean floors, walls and most other non-porous surfaces.

#### 3M™ General Purpose Cleaner Concentrate 8A

- 0.5-gallon bottle
- 4 bottles per case

Each 0.5 gallon bottle yields 35 ready-to-use gallons. (Dilution ratio 1:69.)

#### 3M™ General Purpose Cleaner Concentrate 8H and 8L

- 0.528-gallon bottle
- 6 bottles per case

Each 0.528-gallon bottle yields 35 ready-to-use gallons. (Dilution ratio 1:65.)

### General Use Directions

Dispense 3M™ General Purpose Cleaner Concentrate 8A using the 3M™ Flow Control System Wall Mount Dispenser or the 3M™ Flow Control System Portable Dispenser into a properly labeled container or mop bucket.

Dispense 3M™ General Purpose Cleaner Concentrate 8H and 8L using the 3M™ Twist 'n Fill™ Cleaning Chemical Management System into a properly labeled container or mop bucket.

Improper use or dilution may result in a decrease in product performance, and may increase the risk of health effects.

1. Scrub and dry the surface with a hand pad, cloth or sponge.
2. For floors, cleaner may be used with a mop and bucket or auto scrubber.  
Note: Floors may be slippery when wet.

3. Sweep or dust mop the floor using 3M™ Easy Trap Duster.
4. Properly locate caution signs for wet floor conditions.
5. For light soil, damp mop the floor and allow it to dry.
6. For embedded soil, scrub using a swing machine or auto scrubber equipped with the appropriate 3M™ Floor Pad.
7. If not using an auto scrubber, pick up dirty solution with a wet vacuum or mop.
8. Damp mop with clean solution and let dry. No rinse is required.

### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

**Ready-To-Use:** When used as directed and diluted with a 3M chemical dispensing system: Eye or skin exposure not significant enough to require protection.
