3M 7000 Series Copper Granules, EPA Reg. No. 10350-63, are ceramic-coated minerals used as surfacing material in asphalt roofing products. These granules are colored with durable pigments, bonded in a ceramic matrix and treated to promote adhesion to asphalt. These copper containing granules are part of a system that is used to control algae.
