Store and use all Dyneon Fluoroelastomers only in well ventilated areas under cool and dry conditions. The shelf life of Dyneon Fluoroelastomer FPO 3730 is 3 years from date of manufacturing.

Processing Recommendations

Dyneon Fluoroelastomer FPO 3730 can be compounded using standard water cooled internal mixers or two-roll mills with standard fillers and ingredients utilized in typical fluoroelastomer formulations. The "dry" ingredients should be blended before adding to the masticated gum. For best results, FPO 3730 should be banded on the mill several minutes prior to adding the blended dry ingredients. Once mixed, the compounded stocks have good scorch resistance and storage stability.
