

## Product Description

3M™ White Economy Floor Pad is a floor pad for dry polishing of protected floors, made of synthetic fiber in an open-textured non-woven construction. Polishing particles are dispersed throughout and bonded with a soft resin. Each floor pad has a pre-cut center hole.



## Application

3M™ White Economy Floor Pad is recommended for dry polishing of protected floors under standard and high-speed rotary floor machines.

## Directions for Use

### Dry buffing

- Install a clean floor pad under the machine pad holder
- Dust mop the area or clean it using a 3M™ cleaning floor pad
- Dry buff a section of the floor using a couple of passes
- Then move on to the next section, repeat this process, covering the total floor area required
- Dust mop the entire floor area
- Remove the pad and wash after use

Note: Floors must be clean, free of soil, and in dry conditions prior to dry buffing.

## Maintenance and Cleaning

- Remove the pad from the floor machine after each use and shake to remove dust
- Wash and rinse under tap water to allow soil and debris to wash out
- Can be cleaned in a washing machine if necessary

Note: Machine washing floor pads may shrink by about 20 mm after the first washing cycle.

Recommended washing-machine temperature is 40 °C (higher temperatures will decrease the life of the pad). Hang the pad up or leave it against a vertical surface for drying.

Note: Do not use a wet pad!
